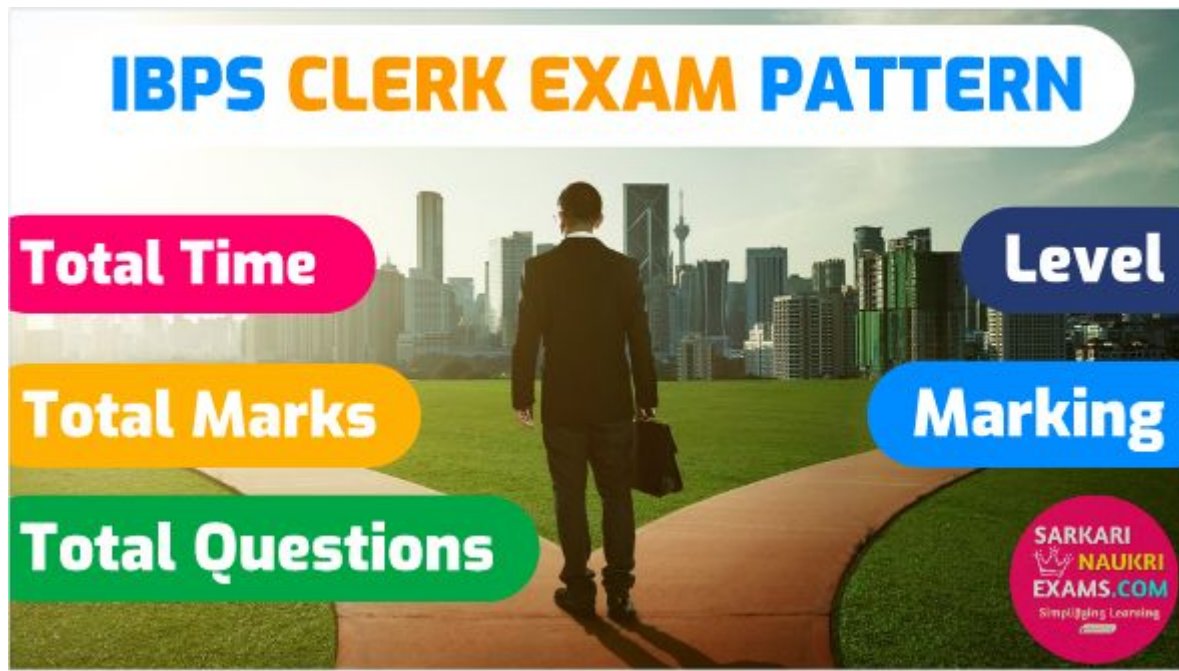

IBPS Clerk Prelims exam has three parts i.e, English Language, Reasoning Ability & Numeric Ability. All questions will be objective type (MCQs). The total duration of time will be 60 minutes and 20 minutes for each section. The total number of questions will be 100. Numeric & Reasoning Ability has an equal number of questions. Total marks will be 100. Each correct answer 1 Marks will be awarded. For each negative answer 0.25 of the marks assigned.

IBPS Clerk Prelims Syllabus 2020: Subject Wise

IBPS Clerk Prelims Syllabus is designed to check reaction time. In other words, it is a war between speed, accuracy and time. For each question, only 01 minutes are given to solve. Most of the questions are added to check their mental ability. English comprehension has 6-8 questions.



Subject Wise Topics:-

IBPS Clerk Syllabus: English Language-

Reading comprehension (RC Passage)

Fillers (Double fillers, Multiple Sentence Fillers, Sentence Fillers)

A filler word is an apparently meaningless word, phrase, or sound that marks a pause or hesitation in speech]

New Pattern Deletion test

A Cloze Reading Test can be denoted as a "deletion test.

Phrase Replacement

Replace a phrase from a given sentence]

Odd Sentence Out cum Para Jumbles

Basically, you are given a paragraph - but the sentences are not in the proper order.

Inference, Sentence Completion

It's a class of semi-structured projective techniques.

Connectors/Conjunctive

They are words that link two similar elements in a given sentence

Paragraph Conclusion

It is somewhat similar to your introduction

Phrasal Verb Related Questions

It's basically a verb and a particle and/or a preposition together form a single semantic unit.

Error Recognition/Detection Questions

Error correction is the ability to find the error and ways to correct it by using your knowledge.

Word usage/ Vocab Based Questions

It is the way a word, phrase, or concept is used in the English language.

IBPS Clerk Syllabus: Numerical Ability

Data Interpretation /DI (Bar Graph, Line Chart, Tabular, Pie Chart)

It is the procedures through which data is reviewed to get the desired result.

Inequalities (Quadratic Equations)

Number Series

It is a form of numbers arranged in a certain sequence, where some numbers are mistakenly kept into the series of numbers. Some numbers are missing from there positions.

Approximation and Simplification

Data Sufficiency

It is basically a question is followed by two or three statements.

HCF

Highest Common Factor (HCF) is found by multiplying all the factors which appear in both lists.

LCM

LCM is the smallest common multiple of two integers like a and b.

Profit and Loss

Profit = Selling Price (S.P.) - Cost price (C.P.) , Loss = Cost price (C.P.) – Selling Price (S.P.)

Simple Interest (SI)

Profit = Selling Price (S.P.) - Cost price (C.P.) , Loss = Cost price (C.P.) – Selling Price (S.P.)

Compound Interest (CI)

The formula for compound interest, including principal sum, is:

$$A = P (1 + r/n)^{nt}$$

Problem on Ages

Find the Age of different people in the different given conditions.

Work and Time

Calculate the work and time for various situations.

Number system

Number system is a system to represent numbers using digits and symbols.

Speed Distance and Time

Speed= Distance/Time, using this formula to solve the given problem.

Probability

Probability is a likelihood that events will occur.

Mensuration

It is calculation result of Geometric shapes, their area, volume and related parameters

Permutation and Combination

Permutations are the various methods in which a collection of items can be arranged. Where as, a combination is a selection of items from a collection

Average

An average represents a single number taken as representative of a list of numbers.

Ratio

It is a relation among two numbers indicating how many times the first number contains the second.

Proportion

A proportion is simply a statement that two ratios are equal. Symbolic representation $a/b = c/d$; or using a colon, $a:b = c:d$

Partnership

A partnership is a formal manage by two or more terms with various operations.

Problems on Boats and Stream

Problems on Trains

Mixture and Allegation

Coding-Decoding
